# CPCCCM2012 Work safely at heights

It provides essential training for individuals who perform tasks at heights. You will learn how to identify fall hazards, use fall protections equipment, and implement safe work procedures to prevent accidents.

This course is appropriate for all workers aiming to gain a formal Work Safely at Heights qualification. As fall risks present a major health and safety issue in many industries, this course may be useful for employees in a wide range of job roles.

This unit of competency does not cover the erection of scaffold or work platforms, but it does include identifying and reporting common faults with scaffold or work platform systems.

This unit also applies to workers in other industries who need to control the two separate risks associated with people and objects falling from heights.

## **Enrolment and Access**

**Training Package Requirements** 

There are no entry requirements for this qualification

## **RTO Entry Requirements**

- ALO only accepts persons 18 years old and over for enrolment into courses/units of competency.
- Be physically fit to be able to access equipment and work at heights.
- Have access to safety boots, gloves, Hi-Viz shirt, work wear for practical activities - long sleeve shirt and trousers.
- Completion of year 10 would be an advantage with achieved equivalent level of language, literacy and numeracy skills. Where this has not occurred, an interview will be conducted to ascertain if there is a potential level of assistance required to assist the student.
- Students must also be able to demonstrate sufficient digital capabilities to complete the program.
- Applicants are to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI) This is obtainable from usi.gov.au If a USI is not supplied and verified with usi.gov.au a Statement of Attainment cannot be issued to the student.
- For courses undertaken in 12 months or less, students will be invoiced the full course fee (including any other essential fees associated with the course).

# To Enrol Eligible Age (5)

You will need to be computer literate and have a basic level of language, literacy and numeracy. You will need to provide your Unique Student Identifier (USI) number to be able to receive your statement of attainment on competent completion.

During enrolment, students will be asked to submit ID documents, as well as a newly taken selfie, as part of confirming their identity.
