TLIF0020 - Safely Access the Rail Corridor course (formerly known) as the Rail Industry Safety Induction, RISI) is a nationally recognised, 100% online training designed for anyone working in or around the rail corridor. Can be completed in one day, this elearning course equips participants with essential knowledge and practical skills to navigate rail safety protocols confidently. You'll learn how to safely access the danger zone, follow correct corridor safety procedures, and respond appropriately to emergencies. Completion of this course ensures compliance for entering operational rail areas across Australia making it a must for rail industry workers.

RTO Entry Requirements:

- ALO only accepts persons 18 years old and over for enrolment into courses/ units of competency.
- ALO recommends that participants should have a basic understanding of English language skills to fully comprehend the course material.
- Completion of year 10 would be an advantage with achieved equivalent level of language, literacy and numeracy skills. Where this has not occurred, an interview will be conducted to ascertain if there is a potential level of assistance required to assist the student.
- Students will need to have access to a computer / tablet / smart phone etc with a reliable internet connection including current email and where applicable up-to-date software, including Microsoft Office and Adobe Acrobat Reader.
- Applicants are to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI) This is obtainable from usi.gov.au If a USI is not supplied and verified with usi.gov.au a statement of attainment cannot be issued to the student.
- For courses undertaken in 12 months or less, students will be invoiced the full course fee (including any other essential fees associated with the course).

Students need to be computer literate and have a basic level of language, literacy and numeracy.

Dress Code

Required to use in practical demonstrations. Have access to personal protective equipment (PPE) - work wear appropriate clothing - long trousers, long sleeve shirt, hi-viz shirt. Closed in work boots.
